- Seizure disorders that increase risk of aspiration, which can complicate pulmonary infections
- Associated comorbid conditions, which may include:
  - Cardiac disease or congenital heart defects
  - Chronic renal disease
  - Diabetes mellitus
  - Pulmonary disorders such as asthma and bronchopulmonary dysplasia
  - Immune dysfunction or use of immunosuppressive medications
  - Metabolic disorders
  - Mitochondrial disorders
