government's agrarian reform into which Shining Path was able to insert itself in Ayacucho and other parts of rural Peru before expanding its reach to the cities, especially Lima. The government's response to this challenge rounds out the discussion, and emphasizes the limitations of effective military action due to internal divisions, institutional rigidities, and economic crisis, but notes the capacity to reorient its focus to intelligence gathering as the Shining Path threat increased.

In sum, Professor Mauerci provides the reader with a well crafted and well written analysis of Peruvian politics at a critical juncture, with a framework which is consistently followed. On balance, however, his presentation, analysis, and interpretation does not take the reader into areas hitherto untrod.

The Politics of Human Rights in Argentina: Protest, Change, and Democratization. By Alison Brysk. (Stanford: Stanford University Press, 1994. Pp. 291. Notes. Bibliography. Index. \$42.50.)

In a carefully researched and well written book, Alison Brysk has presented a significant account of the positive side of one of Argentina's darkest eras. Between 1976 and 1983, Argentines experienced one of their nation's most repressive regimes. During that period, Argentine military officers ruled the state with iron hands, and implemented state terror as a major means by which they silenced their opponents. As a result, tens of thousands of citizens disappeared, presumably tortured and then murdered by agents of their own government.

As Brysk so clearly argues, not all Argentines caved in to state terror. Indeed, human rights groups openly resisted the military, and in so doing devised a number of strategies that allowed them to challenge the state. Seemingly powerless individuals combined a number of campaigns aimed at holding the military regime accountable for the atrocities that they committed in the name of a so-called "Dirty War" against subversives. According to Brysk, among the techniques they used the most effectively included symbolic protest, the gathering of information concerning the missing, and the creation of strong international pressure to hold the Argentine state accountable for its actions.

Brysk has several purposes in mind in writing this book. First, she wanted to chronicle the origins of Argentine human rights movements, and to illustrate their effectiveness against the military dictators. In so doing, she identified three types of groups, some of which pre-dated the military's reign of
