This monograph, then, can be recommended to the general reader interested in a concise description of recent events in the region and a balanced overview of great power policies, but the serious student of Southern African affairs will find it disappointing and at times curiously eccentric.

The author, who was born in Rhodesia, received his doctorate from the University of London, taught for a while at Harvard, and is now in the History Department of the University of Rhodesia in Salisbury. He has had his work on Southern Africa published in *Botswana Notes and Records*, *The International Journal of African Historical Studies*, and in the volume of essays, *Profiles of Self-Determination: African responses to European colonialism in Southern Africa, 1652-present*, edited by his fellow Zimbabwean, David Chanaiswa of California State University at Northridge.

Chief Kgama and His Times, c. 1835-1923: the story of a Southern African ruler is about the grandfather of the President, Sir Seretse Khama (to use the Anglicised spelling). It is very lucidly written by J. Mutero Chirenje, and presents an African perspective on the life and times of this distinguished Chief of the Bamangwato who was lionised in British colonial circles. The two maps are adequate, but hardly exceptional, and the select bibliography contains some extremely valuable observations on source materials, but the author (or perhaps Rex Collings) consistently omits the publishers of all the books, citing them only by author, title, and place and date of publication. This irksome omission, however, is compensated by the truly fine index, which should be a delight for scholar and layman alike.

This short biography appears to be aimed at the non-specialist reader, and provides an excellent introduction to the political, social, and economic history of Botswana from the vantage point of an extremely astute Chief of one of the largest and most sophisticated ethnic groups among the Tswanas. One should read this, along with the fiction of Bessie Head, before moving into the more specialised literature by such scholars as Isaac Schapera and the late Anthony Sillery, a former Resident Commissioner of the Bechuanaland Protectorate.
